## Supplementary Regulations.

Once again, you are cordially invited to take part in the annual VMCC Coventry Parade, to be held on Sunday 11th August 2019 at Coombe Abbey Country Park, Brinklow Road, Coventry, CV3 2AB

This is a non-competitive run, open only to members of the VMCC Ltd, and machines manufactured prior to 1st January 1995. Non VMCC members may join the club on the day for a fee of £5 and may then participate, providing they are on an eligible machine.

Assemble at Coombe Abbey Country Park Events Field from 08:30 (on left hand side of the main driveway nearest the main road; follow event signage)

- **Entrants should ensure that their Third Party Insurance is valid for the event**
- **Machines must conform with all legal requirements**
- **Trade plates are not permitted**
- **Please bring your VMCC membership card on the day – this will be required when signing on.**

Machines will park in their designated area (oldest first) and will be flagged off at 30 second intervals in programme order; number one away at 11:00.

Riders may travel at their own speed and stop when they wish.

A suggested route of approximately 50 miles will be supplied to participants, with the option of a shorter route for older machines.

Both routes have a common destination for a lunch stop en-route which is the Pailton Ex Servicemens and Social Club, CV23 0QB.

There will be a fully licenced burger and food bar at this venue for entrants to choose their own lunch fayre (vegetarian options available). Tea and coffee will also be available. All purchases made at the snack bar will help our chosen charity, which, for this year, is Prostate Cancer Research.

The Servicemens Club will be serving a range of drinks from their licenced bar.

Participants may consume their own food at the lunch stop if they wish.

It must be emphasised that whilst the route is recommended as interesting, there is no obligation for riders to comply. Should they wish to take an alternative route they may, providing that they return to the start by 14:45.

All machines taking part in the run will be judged for awards, providing that the entrant has signed off at the organiser's control desk by 15:00.

There are facilities to allow parking of transport and trailers etc on the events field. Please follow the marshals instructions, and park neatly with consideration.

Upon arrival, before signing on, please read the event health and safety information sheet that will be provided on the day and please ensure that you make every effort to ensure that you comply with what is written within this document.

All entry and lunch monies are non-refundable. **Closing date for official entries is 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019 but late entries will be accepted on the day at a cost of £15.00 for all classes.**
